Sir,

With reference to your letter dated 24/5/16 I have to inform you that, there is no objection to carry out Dental /Eye/TB/SKIN Checkup Camp in 10 MCGM Schools by CARC during Academic Year 2016-2017. subject to the following conditions.

- 1 Permission from Education Officer and respective A.O. (S) should be obtained in advance to carry out Dental /Eye/TB SKIN Checkup Camp in 10 MCGM Schools by CARC during Academic Year 2016-2017
- 2 Before starting the work, the programme of visiting the schools with dates should be prepared in consultation with M.O.(S)/ A.O.(S) of corresponding wards.
- 3 The date of starting the above mentioned check up should be intimated in advance to M.O. (S)'s office and the Head Teachers of the Municipal Schools.
- 4 The above mentioned check up should be carried out by Medical and Para Medical Personnel only.
- 5 Written consent of the parents of the students should be obtained before taking them for investigations / treatment / intervention.
- 6 The record of the Dental /Eye/TB/SKIN check up work carried out in the school should be maintained and detailed report such as names of the children, standard, division, defect / diagnosis and treatment given should be submitted to M.O. (S)'s office.
- 7 The expenditure on account of this work will not be paid by this Corporation
- 8 The treatment for affected students arranged by CACR should be free of cost.
- 9 The school health department also refers affected students noticed during the screening examination to MCGM dispensaries and hospitals with their parents' consent. Similarly, students notified by CACR to M.O (Schools) will be referred for treatment with parents' consents. TB treatment is provided free at all DOTS centres under RNTCP.
