TO WHOM SO EVER IT MAY CONCERN



IDA has conducted 4 dental checkup camps for apprx. **2475 municipal school students** in 2016-17. CACR has facilitated the entire process from obtaining permissions, coordination with school authorities, medical health officers to following up with government dispensaries and clinics to make sure that the children diagnosed with dental problems receive prompt treatment.

The team of dentists from IDA has distributed free samples of toothbrushes and toothpaste along with giving a demonstration of good brushing techniques and oral care regimen to all children attending the camps.

Thanks to the initiative taken by CACR, for arranging **Oral Health awareness and ill effects of Tobacco lecture** via BMC's virtual classroom studio to educate over **1,00,000 BMC school students** about oral health guidelines and best practices as well as inspire the students to work hard and achieve their goals in life.
