This is to certify Citizens Association for Child Rights (CACR) have successfully implemented the Project Handwashing with Soap (HWWS), an integral part of Project WASH (Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene) as per Swachh Bharat Swachh Vidyalaya Guideline of Government of India.

This project was implemented in 38 municipal schools and 1 Rotary club community center across Mumbai reaching out to 3235 children by a team of volunteers, coordinators and project head with support and guidance from UNICEF Resource team, involving the officials of MCGM Education Department.

As reported by school teachers and volunteers after this 12-week intervention program there has been a gradual behavior change in the students. They wash their hands at critical times in school and also educate their family members about this good hygiene practice at home.

Regular updates on the project implementation: sharing of school wise data, photographs, attendance sheet and feedback from teachers in respective schools have all been maintained. The session on Menstrual Hygiene management (MHM) was also conducted in 3 schools at Colaba with 200 girl students from 8th and 9th standards along with their mothers and teachers.

This pilot should be scaled up to many more municipal schools across Mumbai.
